Dear Supporters and Prayer Partners,

The Evento Keystone in Riberalta, Bolivia is now history and as the words of David Phelps' song say we are at "the end of the beginning." In the next few months we will see if the leaders become intentional in making disciples who reproduce in more disciples. For this reason it is so important that the coaching for the next six months is faithfully done. Will you please pray for the coaches as they find time to diligently mentor the leaders in their care? We also need you to pray for the leaders, as they need to report to their coaches weekly. If both sides do their part there is a good chance that within two years most of these leaders will reach the fourth generation in their disciple-making. What a joy it will be to see this!

This Evento was very unique. Often we train people who want to make disciples but really aren't focused on reaching the unreached People Groups IUPGI but this group of leaders not only come from some of these groups but are preparing to go back and give their lives to seeing these people



groups come to know Jesus as Savior and Lord. In the strategies that each leader wrote there are at least eight UPGs being targeted in countries like India, Iran, Bolivia, Tibet, Peru, Costa Rica. These are bold visions and ministry plans given by the Holy Spirit to these leaders. It's inspiring to hear their stories and sense the deep faith they have in Christ. It will be exciting to see what the Lord does through them.



This Evento would not have happened without the help of two couples. James and Jenny Wolheter are missionaries who have recently joined World Partners after more than twenty years of service in Bolivia. They have worked in leadership development and when they return to Bolivia in the Spring of 2024 they will again be located in Cochabamba. They will be coaching a few of the leaders from the Evento. What an example of complete and unreserved dedication to see the

gospel spread to the ends of the earth. We were so blessed to meet them and join them in realizing the vision the Lord has given them. You would do well to pray for this couple as they do this great work of training future missionaries from Latin America to go into all the world and make disciples for the glory of the Father.

Just as Nat returned from Bolívía we receíved this emaîl from World Partners. "Nat and Donna, I wasn't able to view the October reports prior to the November payroll, so that gives you a "reprieve" from a lower salary. However, that does mean you will receive a decreased salary in December ... The funds you received through October 2023 were 85.1% of your year-to-date budget for 2023. I wanted to alert you to this shortfall so you are aware you will now experience a salary decrease." [The shortfall is close to \$10,000 as of October]



The Lord has always been faithful to provide what we need and we know

that he will this time. However, there may be some of you who would like to give some extra at the end of the year to help us cover this shortfall. We would greatly appreciate any help that can be given. 2024 holds opportunities that we are looking forward to being a part of and your continued support will make that possible.

We pray that you will have a great Holiday Season as you celebrate the coming of the King of Kings. His is still working things out for his glory but the world needs each of us sharing with those around us the good news that a Savior has come and his name is JESUS!

We want to leave you with two very urgent requests. Jaime, the President of the Missionary Church in Ecuador just needed stints placed in his heart after what appears to have been two light heart attacks. He has also found out that he is diabetic. Marco, the President of the Missionary Church of Honduras also appears to have had a heart attack! These are godly men who are doing a great work and we are asking for special prayer for them and the denominations that they lead. The phrase that can be applied here is, "God has no problems only plans."

Thanks for your support and standing with us in this endeavor for the Kingdom. We are honored to represent you as we serve.
